Dear Parents/Guardians,

The weeks are certainly passing quickly! It is very hard to believe that we are already around the half way mark of the first term.

We have had a great fortnight since our last newsletter. We are seeing some very positive choices from our students and we are even seeing children hold themselves accountable to choices they have made. I am sure that you all read the Compass post this week about increasing our expectations around student behaviour. I have been very pleased in the response from our students and their ability to reflect and be honest. I am confident that if we are consistent in our increased expectations we will soon be in a very different place. If your child/ren comes home and tells you that something happened, please encourage them to tell a teacher before leaving school. You are more than welcome to call and fill us in on what has happened to ensure we are then able to follow it up the next day. What we do not want to see is parents approaching other students about an incident. Please let us manage what happens here at school. If you feel that it has not been managed or you are unsure of what the outcome was, please call and check in with us rather than approach another student.

All school's go through a cycle of review with the Department of Education. From this review, schools write a Strategic Plan which sees a focus set for the next four years. We are this year at the end of our Strategic Plan and will be completing a review in Term 2. This Term, our focus is on preparing for the review and completing a self reflection. Stay tuned for information on how you can participate in the self reflection as we will be looking for parents/guardians who would like to contribute. This may be as simple as answering a reflective question from Mrs Ormsby or myself when you walk through the gate.

Thank you to the parents that have nominated to be a part of our 2022 School Council. I was very pleased to see the number of nominations come in. It is great to see parents keen to be a part of the direction of our school. We have received enough nominations that we will be holding a ballot. In the next day to two you will receive a ballot form and an information page introducing the nominated parents. Please take some time to read this and place your vote. You just simply fill in the form and place in one of the envelopes. You then place the blank envelope with the ballot form in the other provided envelope and write your name on the front. These votes are confidential, I am the only person who will see who you have voted for.

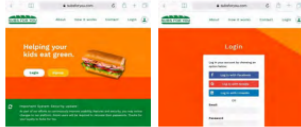
