Important Information

- Orders must be placed by the due date in order for your child to receive their pack for the first day of Term 1.
- Orders placed after the due date will not be delivered to the school until mid February due to our extremely busy schedule in January. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Please order early to avoid disappointment. We apologise if you are a new enrolment or missed the due date due to unavoidable circumstances, but the school is aware your pack won't be ready on the first day of school, so your child should not be disadvantaged.
- All packs will be delivered to the school and cannot be collected from Paperchase.
- Complete packs only can be ordered through Paperchase Booklist Website. We do not have a walk-in shop and individual items cannot be purchased. All orders must be placed online.
