LITERACY

In Reading, the Preps will be learning about letters and sounds and making predictions in the stories they read. This term is all about fostering good reading habits. The students will be bringing home a reading bag filled with various activities and books for them to enjoy with you. We would love you to find time to read these books or complete some of these activities with your child every night.

In Writing, our Preps will be focusing on developing a correct pencil grip, letter formation- correctly forming upper and lowercase letters and drawing pictures to match their written message.

SMART Foundation: Each week our Preps will participate in a range of literacy activities revolving around a word and sentence of the week; shared experience (typically a craft activity), word building, handwriting and sentence writing. Example: Word of the week 'ant' Sentence: 'That ant had a hat.'



In Numeracy, we will be focusing on the following mathematical concepts:

- Number recognition and value (subitising)
- Counting
- 2D Shapes
- Location
- Ordinal Number
- Patterns
